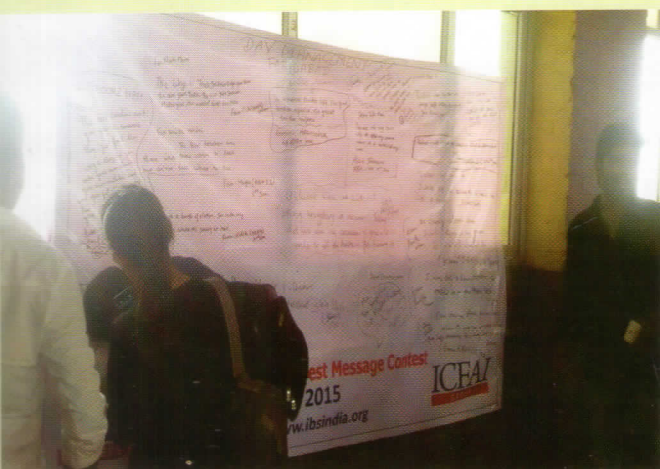

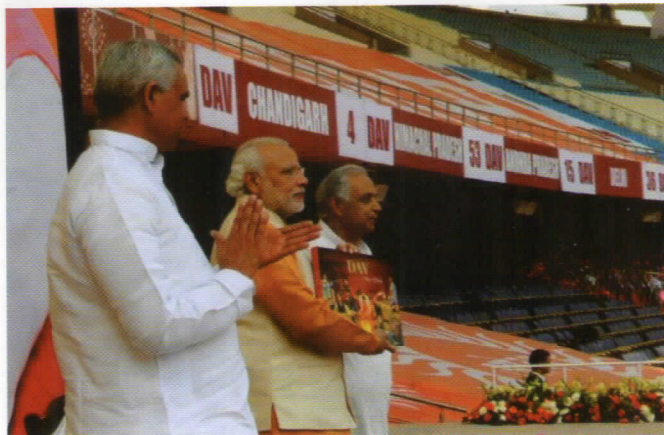
The entire MBA and MCA Department wished the students all the best for their new area of studies.
